

## **PUBLIC WARNING NOTICE**

## FROM THE COMMISSIONER OF NOTHERN TERRITORY CONSUMER AFFAIRS

## Issued under section 223 of the Australian Consumer Law

Joseph Ronald Gass trading as Drover Industries (ABN 99 707 594 551)

The Commissioner of Consumer Affairs is issuing a public warning notice to caution consumers not to deal with Joseph (Joe) Gass trading as Drover Industries.

Consumer Affairs has received a number of complaints and enquiries from consumers who have had dealings with Drover Industries in respect of concrete swimming pool and landscaping installation. The complaints allege:

- The trader takes payment for work which is not completed
- Unreasonable delay or failure to complete the installation
- Substandard workmanship
- The trader fails to pay back money for incomplete work
- Consumers incur costs to have work rectified or finished

The Commissioner is warning the public about the alleged conduct as the Commissioner:

- 1. Has reasonable grounds to suspect that it may constitute breaches of the Australian Consumer Law.
- 2. Is satisfied that one or more persons has suffered, or is likely to suffer detriment as a result of the alleged conduct; and
- 3. Is satisfied that it is in the public interest to issue a public warning notice.
